



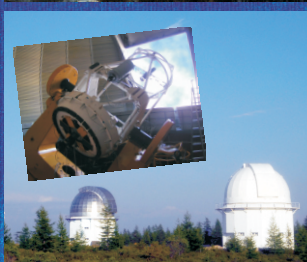

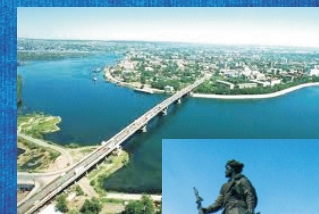
The workshop aims to promote the science

of the Sun-Earth system science, including:

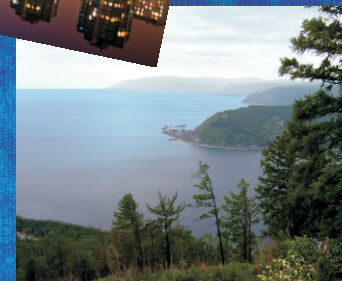
- observations, theory, modeling

Irkutsk is a historical city and gateway to the
world-famous Lake Baikal. It was founded
as a small wooden fort in 1661. At present,
it is a large city with about 600.000 population.
Located 70 km northwest of Lake Baikal,
on the Angara River banks, Irkutsk is the
administrative, cultural, historical
and educational center of the region.
Irkutsk International Airport connects the city
with direct flights to major cities in Russia,
Europe and some Asian countries such as
China, South Korea, Mongolia.



Venue of the workshop is “Irkutsk” hotel.
It is located on the Angara river bank.
The hotel is within walking distance to all
major sights of Irkutsk. It has a conference
hall with the capacity of up to 200 persons,
